SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA 2017

1. Student must reside in one of the following counties: Lawrence, Orange, Greene, Washington, Martin, Monroe or Jackson.
2. Student must complete BBOR Scholarship Application and submit to the Scholarship Committee at the Bedford Board of Realtors Office, located at 1835 Steven Avenue, Bedford, IN 47421.
3. Applications must be received by March 15, 2018 for consideration, even if the student has not yet been accepted to a college or university. (The name of the college can be added at a later date.) NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED.
4. Student must be the child, stepchild, grandchild or legal ward of a primary or secondary member of the Bedford Board of Realtors. (Affiliate members are NOT eligible.)
5. A copy of transcripts/grades (first semester of senior year) must be attached to application, as well as proof of SAT scores. A 3.0 grade point average (B) or above (or the equivalent) will be considered.
6. Student must be in good standing with the high school he/she is attending. (Principal, Vice-Principle or School Counselor to sign application.)
7. On behalf of the student, scholarship money will be sent directly to the college/university from the Bedford Board of Realtors with a copy of the letter forwarded to the student.
8. Two (\$250.00) scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis. The top two recipients will be chosen from a point system. Points are based on GPA, SAT scores, Extra Curricular Activities, Work Experience, Community Involvement and Honors/Awards.
