- 3. Applicants must have been accepted to an accredited college of university in pursuit of an associate or bachelors degree and majoring in accounting.
- 4. Award(s) of \$500 to \$2,500 will be paid directly to the scholarship recipient(s). Depending on number of qualified applications, scholarships awarded may be less than \$2,500.
- 5. Applicant consideration will be based on academic achievement, school and community involvement, and future plans of the applicant in the field of accounting.
- 6. The applications will be considered by and the recipient(s), if any, chosen by the Blue & Co., LLC Southern Indiana Directors and Recruiting Committee.
