

JACKSON COUNTY RECYCLING DISTRICT ENVIRONMENTAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Jackson County Solid Waste Management District offers 5 - \$1,000 scholarships annually to graduating seniors. This scholarship is available to seniors in any Jackson County High School. The scholarship is also available to graduating home-schooled students who provide verification of graduation eligibility. Applicants must be able to demonstrate an interest in environmental affairs through an essay of 250 – 500 words describing the importance of recycling in today's world. Include what part you have had in recycling or environmental stewardship programs.

Please attach the essay to a cover page that includes your name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, high school you attend or home school information and your parents' or guardians' names. Do NOT include academic transcripts or personal financial information. Do NOT put your name on the essay pages as this scholarship is selected anonymously.

It is strongly suggested that the essay be submitted typed or hand-written double-sided on recycle-content paper.
