- 3. Copy of HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT.
- 4. **OTHER DOCUMENTATION** (if other documentation is required, it is listed below, next to the scholarship or fund name).
- 5. A PERSONAL LETTER to fully explain why you need financial assistance to attend college, what this scholarship would mean to you, whether you are contributing financially to your education, what your educational and career goals are, and what factors have influenced your education and career decision. Supply any additional information for which there is not sufficient room on this form.

MAKE A DIFFERENCE Scholarship

- Must reside in Seymour Community Schools District
- Financial need, circumstances of hardship a consideration
- Moral character and motivation
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members; prefer one from the field of education and one from the community-at-large. Letters of recommendation are to include information relative to moral character, motivation, goals, and financial need.
- May be renewable for subsequent years

MAKE A DIFFERENCE Career Scholarship

- Must reside in Seymour Community School District
- Financial need, circumstances of hardship a consideration
- This fund is primarily for working adults (non-high school students), but can provide scholarships for graduating seniors not pursuing a traditional college track. Non-degree seeking students must pursue vocational or career related certifications through accredited educational or instructional programs.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members; prefer one from the field of education and one from the community-at-large. Letters of recommendation are to include information relative to moral character, motivation, goals, and financial need.
