



Special Circumstances



Changes to your situation not represented on the FAFSA may include:

- ➤ Change in employment or income status
- Medical expenses not covered by insurance
- ► Change in parent marital status
- Unusual dependent care expenses
- ➤ Student unable to obtain parent information



Each college provides a financial aid offer outlining the following:

- ➤ Cost of attendance
- ➤ Financial aid amounts (Grants, scholarships, work study & loans)
- ➤ Options to pay remaining balance

Timing & delivery of offer varies by college

What you should do:

- Review costs and financial aid offers
- Clearly understand your obligations
- ➤ Ask questions



Comparison Tips



Federal Aid is typically the same at each school

- Subsidized & unsubsidized loan amounts could vary based on:
 - + School cost
 - **♦** Other financial aid received

State aid varies based on:

- ➤ School classification (Public, Private, Ivy Tech & Proprietary)
- ➤ **Program** (Frank O'Bannon vs. 21st Century Scholars)

Institutional aid varies by college/university





Finalize Your Funding Plan



Plan for the full year

- ➤ Financial aid offers are for the year
- ➤ Billing is done by term

Confirm how outside scholarships are applied

➤ Split between 2 terms or all in one

If you need to borrow to fill a funding gap

- ➤ Shop to determine best option
- ➤ Estimate amount for full year
 - ◆ You can always reduce the spring disbursement to minimize loan total

- Note any action items required to secure awards offered, renewal requirements & deadlines
- ➤ Share <u>ALL</u> outside scholarships you receive
- > Any changes to your family situation

Stay in contact with other offices regarding

- ► Housing forms and deposits
- > Payment deadlines for first term
- ➤ Freshman registration & orientation
- ➤ Work study process
